


Rat or Mouse?









Mice and juvenile rats can look very similar but there's a couple of features to look for to help tell them apart.

As a general rule, **juvenile rats have bigger features** relative to their body size and look slightly out of proportion.

This includes bigger feet ('clown feet'), head, ears and also a thicker tail.

Whereas, a mouse's feet, head, ears, and tail look proportionate to its body size.
